Pensions & Retirement: Leaves of Absence

Sometimes, you need to pause your work to take care of another responsibility, whether that's a new baby, a family illness or your own education. If you take an approved leave of absence, you can choose to buy service for that leave.

If you are returning from a leave of absence, the BCTF highly recommends you buy back your service because when you buy service, you increase your pensionable and contributory service. Pensionable service is used to calculate your pension at retirement. Contributory service determines if your pension will be reduced and by how much.

If your family member becomes ill, there are some leaves in our contract that allow teachers to take the time off they need, for a few different circumstances.
