

## Teachers are seeing the effects of poverty in their classrooms



53% of teachers in low-income schools indicated "most" or "all" students have the school supplies they need at the start of the school year compared to 94% of teachers in high-income schools.

Raise social assistance, including disability rates for families






Establish progressive taxation to help increase funding in education
